CURIOUS ABOUT WHAT INNER CITY YOUTH MINISTRY IS DOING?

The following is an overview of some of the programs that ICYM has run this past year.

LUNCH CONNECTION

LC is a free lunch program serving students in priority neighborhood schools. Currently lunch connection is active in Saint John the Baptist/King Edward School, Hazen White, and Centennial in partnership with Portland United Church.

On Mondays we partner with Trinity Church for "Manwich Monday" a hot lunch program for students from St. Malachy's and Saint John High.

YOUTH CONNECTION

Youth Connection is a joint ministry of ICYM and Central Saint John Community Ministry. We meet Wednesday evenings from 6:00-7:30 on the second floor of trinity. Each week we have supper as a group as well as time for games and discussion.

ICYM CAMP

Each year Inner City Youth Ministry sends a group of kids to Camp Brookwood for ICYM camp week! This years kids will be from Centennial school. The Inner City Youth Director is the chaplain for the week.

SUMMER PRAYER REQUESTS

ICYM CAMP

FOOD INSECURITY
